The natural scenery isn't the only marvel though. The TranzAlpine passes through the Otira Tunnel, a true engineering marvel of 100 years!
	Once you arrive on the West Coast, a private coach will take you even further off the beaten track to Punakaiki Pancake Rocks. Here you will explore curious limestone formations and blowholes before finishing your day in the ocean-front town of Hokitika.
